

Conditions of Entry specific to Youth Art

- You must be in Year 7 to Year 13 on the 31st July 2017.
- You may enter up to 3 pieces of work into any of the 8 Sections / 17 Categories exhibiting in the festival.
- Each work must conform to the Conditions of Entry specific to each category. These can be found on the individual entry forms for each section. Entry forms for all categories can be found on our website franklinartsfestival.com
- Please read all Conditions of Entry carefully and note any specifics, ie. *Sculptural Art - base must not exceed 750mm x 750mm.*
- The entry fee for each Youth entry is \$10.

Generic Conditions for all Entries

All works must be for sale

- Price must include **30% commission** and account for GST.

Original Art only

- All works must be original and not infringe the copyright of any other artist. Work must have been completed since September 2016. Work must not have been exhibited elsewhere.

Labelling your work

- **Please ensure your name, address, phone number, section and title of the piece and price are marked on the work and/or packaging of the work.**

Damage / Loss Insurance

All insurance is the responsibility of the artist. While all due care will be taken, the Arts Festival Committee is not responsible for any damage or loss that may occur.

Confidentiality

- Artist contact details will not be supplied to outside parties without consent of the artist. Contact details of those who purchase artwork at the Festival will also remain confidential.

Publicity

- By entering this competition, the artist agrees that the Franklin Arts Festival Society may use the entry for all promotional and media purposes.

Important notice: The committee reserves the right to remove the 3rd prize from sections where there are too few artists contributing work.

Delivery & Collection

Delivery of entry forms and fees - 31st July 2017

- Incomplete or ineligible entry forms will be returned.
- **No late entries will be accepted.**
- No title or price changes will be accepted after entry closing date.

Delivery of Art Work - Tuesday 29th August

- All works to be delivered by hand on **Tuesday 29th August** between **10.00am** and **7.00pm** to the Pukekohe Town Hall.
- Work will not be accepted unless entry fees have been paid.

Delivery address for Couriers:

- Art work may be Couriered in the week **prior** to the Festival to arrive no later than the 29th August:

- All works sent by Courier or Post must be packaged in suitable containers for repacking and return (with a return of address visible) if not sold.
- **IMPORTANT** Please include a **Return Courier ticket** for all items (entered) to be returned by Courier.

The Festival - 2nd September - 10th September

- Open from 9.30am - 4.30pm (**except Sunday 10th** - 2pm close)
- Opening Gala Night. Fri 1st September, 7pm (Door sales available)
- If your work is sold you will be informed by telephone.

Collection of work - 2.00 - 4pm 10th September only

- Your receipt of entry must be sighted by the Section Convener before work is released. Please note: Work will not be released unless this is available.
- Alternative arrangements may be made for delivery and collection if required.

Entries not collected within 7 days of the collection date will become the property of the Festival.
