

Conditions of Entry specific to Youth Art

- You must be in Year 7 to Year 13 on the 31st July 2018.
- You may enter up to 3 pieces of work into any of the 8 Sections / 17 Categories exhibiting in the festival.
- Each work must conform to the Conditions of Entry specific to each category. These can be found on the individual entry forms for each section. Entry forms for all categories can be found on our website franklinartsfestival.com
- Please read all Conditions of Entry carefully and note any specifics, e.g. *Sculptural Art - base must not exceed 750mm x 750mm.*
- The entry fee for each Youth entry is \$10.

Generic Conditions for all Entries

Youth entries DO NOT HAVE TO BE FOR SALE

- Selling your work is **OPTIONAL** in the Youth section (only).
- If you choose to sell your work, the price must include the festival's **30% commission** and account for 15% GST.

Original Art only

- All works must be original and not infringe the copyright of any other artist.
- The work must have been completed since September 2017.
- Work must not have been exhibited anywhere else in New Zealand.

Labelling your work

- **Please ensure your name, address, phone number, section, title of the piece, and price are marked clearly on the work and/or packaging of the work.**

Damage / Loss Insurance

All insurance is the responsibility of the artist. Whilst all due care will be taken, the Franklin Arts Festival Committee is not responsible for any damage or loss that may occur.

Prizes. Important notice:

- In any section where there are too few artists contributing work, the committee reserves the right to remove 3rd prize from the section

Confidentiality

- Artist contact details will not be supplied to outside parties without consent of the artist. Contact details of those who purchase artwork at the Festival will also remain confidential.

Publicity

- By entering this competition, the artist agrees that the Franklin Arts Festival Society may use the entry for all promotional and media purposes.

Delivery & Collection

Delivery of entry forms and fees - 31st July 2018

- Incomplete or ineligible entry forms will be returned.
- **No late entries will be accepted.**
- No title or price changes will be accepted after the entry closing date.

Delivery of Art Work - Tuesday 28th August

- All works to be hand delivered between **10.00am** and **7.00pm** to the Pukekohe Town Hall.
- Work will not be accepted unless entry fees have been paid.

Delivery by Courier

- Art work may be Couriered in the week **before** the Festival, not earlier than Tuesday 21st August and no later than Tuesday 28th August.
- The address: **Attn. Franklin Art Gallery, 12 Massey Avenue, Pukekohe, 2120**
- All couriered work must be packed in suitable containers for repackaging and return if the work is not sold. Please have your name and address on courier packaging. **Important!** Please include a return courier ticket.

The Festival

- Opening Night and Prize giving **Friday 31st August 7.00 pm** (door sales available)

The Festival times

- **Saturday 1st September to Sunday 9th September**
Open from 9.30 to 4.30 daily (except Sunday 9th - closes at 1.00pm)

Collection of work

- **Sunday 9th September 2.00 - 4.00pm**
- Your receipt of entry must be sighted by the Section Convenor before work is released. Please note: work will not be released unless this is available
- Alternative arrangements may be made for delivery and collection of work if required.

Entries not collected within 7 days of the collection date become the property of the Festival.
